COMPLAINT

Comes the Plaintiff and files this lawsuit against Defendant pursuant to Section 216(b) of the Fair Labor Standards Act (hereinafter "FLSA"), and for her cause of action states as follows:

1 Defendant Guardian Angel Nursing, Inc. ("Guardian Angel") is a Tennessee corporation. Its registered agent for service of process is E L Garner, III, 5968 Knight Arnold Road, Memphis, Tennessee, 38187-2194.

2. The Court has subject matter jurisdiction over this action pursuant to 28 U S C. Section 1331.

3. At all times material to this action, the Defendant was an enterprise engaged in commerce or in the production of goods for commerce as defined by Section 203(s)(1) of the FLSA, and had annual gross volume of sales which exceeded \$500,000 00.

4 Plaintiff was employed by Defendant within the last three years before the filing of this lawsuit

5 While Plaintiff worked for Defendant, Defendant was an "employer" of Plaintiff as defined by Section 203(d) of the FLSA.

6 While Plaintiff worked for Defendant, Plaintiff was an "employee" of Defendant

as defined by Section 203(e)(1) of the FLSA, and worked for Defendant within the territory of the United States within three years preceding the filing of this lawsuit.

7 The minimum wage and overtime provisions of the FLSA set forth in Sections 206 and 207, respectively, apply to Defendant.

8. While Plaintiff was employed by Defendant, she was an hourly employee who was entitled to overtime wages at a rate of one and one-half times her regular rate of pay for hours worked over 40 in a given workweek, pursuant to Section 207 of the FLSA

9. While Plaintiff was employed by Defendant, she worked more than 40 hours per work week during certain work weeks, but was not paid overtime wages at a rate of one and one-half times her regular rate of pay for all hours worked over 40 in a given workweek as required by Section 207 of the FLSA.

10. Defendants' violations of Section 207 of the FLSA were willful.

11. Defendants' violations of Section 207 of the FLSA were not in good faith.

12. As a result of Defendants' failure to comply with Section 207 of the FLSA, Defendant is liable to Plaintiff for overtime back pay

13 In addition to the amount of unpaid overtime wages owing to Plaintiff, Plaintiff is also entitled to recover an equal amount of liquidated damages pursuant to 29 USC. Section 216(b).

14 Plaintiff is entitled to an award of attorney's fees pursuant to 29 U.S.C. § 216(b).

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff prays for a judgment against the Defendant that includes an award of damages for the following:

1 Overtime back pay;

2 An equal amount of liquidated damages, pursuant to Section 216(b) of the FLSA;

3 Reasonable attorney's fees;

- 5. Such other, further general legal and equitable relief to which she may be entitled.
