Plaintiff, appearing pro se and incarcerated at Five Points Correctional Facility, brings the instant 42 U.S.C. § 1983 complaint alleging violations of his constitutional rights while confined at Eastern Correctional Facility.¹ The Eastern Correctional Facility is located in Ulster County in the Northern District of New York. See 28 U.S.C. § 112(a). As the events alleged in the instant complaint occurred in the Northern District of New York, I hereby transfer this action to the United States District Court for the Northern District of New York.

Venue

Under 28 U.S.C. § 1391, a § 1983 action may be brought only in:

- (1) a judicial district where any defendant resides, if all defendants reside in the same State, (2) a judicial district in which a substantial part of the events or omissions giving rise to the claim occurred, or a substantial part of the property that is the subject of

the action is situated, or (3) a judicial district in which any defendant may be found, if there is no district in which the action may otherwise be brought.

Since the alleged events giving rise to this claim occurred in the Northern District of New York, this action should be and hereby is transferred to the United States District Court for the Northern District of New York. 28 U.S.C. §§ 1391(b), 1406(a).

The Clerk of this Court shall file and docket the complaint without payment of fees. Whether plaintiff should be permitted to proceed further without payment of fees or under the fee payment schedule set forth in the Prison Litigation Reform Act of 1995, Pub. L. No. 104-134, 110 Stat. 1321 (1996), is a determination to be made by the transferee court. That provision of Rule 83.1 of the Local Rules for the Southern District of New York which requires a five day delay is waived. A summons shall not issue from this Court for this action.

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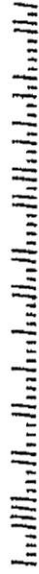
